Greetings, my name is CM Andy King & I represent the 12th Council District in the Bronx which consists of Edenwald, Gun Hill, Baychester, Wakefield, Eastchester and Co-Op City. I was first elected on November 6, 2012 in a Special Election. In my first 6 months of taking office, I co-sponsored both the Community Safety Act and the Paid Sick Time Act, allocated \$813,000 to programs that provide nutritional assistance to District 12 residents, added \$300,000 to The NAACP's Williamsbridge Early Childhood Center, and introduced Bill 1091 which would mandate the department of education to provide information on college saving plans to new students. I have held several workshops in the community on the topics of Foreclosures, Small Business improvement, and Tax-Liens. I am also working closely with the Department of Transportation to improve the flow of traffic within the district and with the Department of Sanitation to improve our White Plains Road Business Corridor. In order to progress forward, we must employ community accountability. This ideal was ingrained in me by my father before me who also took up the mantle of community leadership. This was my home long before it was my Council District, and I served my community long before I held an office. This September 10, I ask that you allow me the honor of continuing to deliver the change we voted for by re-electing me for my first full term as your City Council Member.
